1-ENVIRONMENT AND PROBLEMS

During next decades, the relation between the environmental quality and human health will become one of the major stakes of the modern society, because the man does not cease degrading the environment in various ways, through the bad waste management, but also through other actions undertaken. Solid waste causes disease and accident, pollution, obstruction, dirtiness.

2-Solid waste can be classified in two groups:

Waste housewives and assimilable, made up of the refuse produced by the households, the markets, the craftsmen.

The industrial waste made up of inert waste (rubble, remainders of building materials on the building sites, the wreck of car and the apparatuses electric household appliances) waste of agricultural and food industries (that one finds with SARIS), waste of the breweries, waste of the farms of breeding and the slaughter-houses, biomedical waste (resulting from the hospitals, the medical cabinets and the pharmaceutical laboratories). The controlled discharges are non-existent. The refuse collected by the private individuals is throw in the wild discharges (in the city even) in the gutters or the drain in the open air, of this fact blocking this work which cannot more not let run the surface water. The zones are flooded by stagnant waters and nauseous.

3-General objective:

To educate and show the population of Brazzaville city, it is possible to fight against the waste pollution and have a good management of waste.

- . Sensitize and inform the population in Brazzaville City on the interest to keep our own environment and healthy environment with the support of all the social actors;
